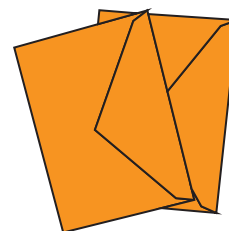

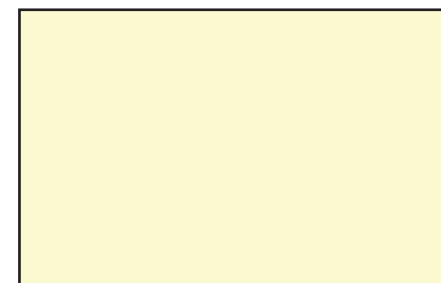


ENVELOPE BOOKLETS

You will need:



2 envelopes (9cm x 13cm)

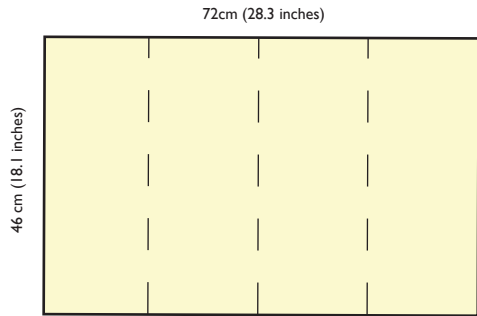


1 sheet of paper (46cm x 72cm)

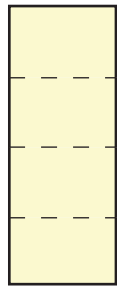


The size of the paper will depend on the size of the envelopes and paper that you have available.

This amazing envelope design was created by our master teaching artist Joy Suarez. 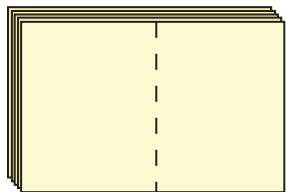
1: Cut piece of paper into 4.



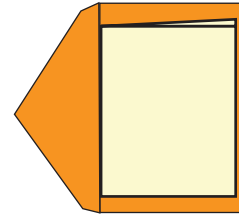
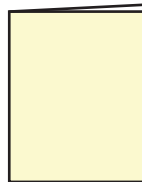
2: Cut each piece into 4 again.



3: Take 5 of these pieces of paper (this will give you 10 page in the book)

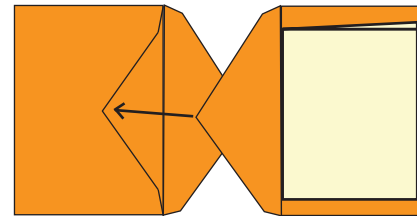
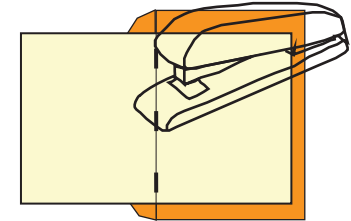


4: Place the 5 pieces of paper in a pile and fold in half.



5: Line up the folded edge of the paper with the crease of the envelope.

6: Staple the envelope to the paper pages, where the fold of the paper meets the crease of the envelope.



7: Slide the flap of first envelope into the second envelope, until the creases of both envelopes meet.

8: Close the book and glue the flap of the second envelope to the back of the book.
