1.	TAKE THREE TOILET PAPER ROLLS AND CUT IT IN HALF. OR TAKE ONE PAPER TOWEL ROLL, AND CUT IT INTO 6 SEGMENTS.	
2.	USE GLUE, TAPE, FABRIC, PAPER, MARKER, AND PAINT TO COVER YOUR BIG BEAD.	
3.	THEN DECORATE YOUR BEAD WITH SMALLER DETAILS. INCLUDING: SMALLER PIECES OF COLORED PAPER, PIECES OF STRING, ALUMINUM FOIL, AND ANYTHING THAT WILL ALLOW YOUR BEAD TO SPARKLE.	
4.	WHEN YOU'RE DONE WITH YOUR BEADS, DECIDE WHERE EACH BEAD WILL GO. WHICH ONE GOES IN THE MIDDLE?	
5.	CONNECT ALL YOUR BEADS WITH A PIECE OF STRING. IF YOU DON'T HAVE STRING, YOU CAN USE: YARN, PLASTIC WRAP, CHORD, OR AN OLD T-SHIRT!	
6.	AND WEAR YOUR STATEMENT NECKLACE PROUDLY!
